FIRST AID

If swallowed:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Call a poison control center or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Do not induce vomiting unless told to by the poison control center or doctor. Do not give any liquid to the person. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person.
If in eyes:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15-20 minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled:	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-mouth if possible. Call a poison control center or doctor for treatment advice.
Have the product container or label with you when calling a poison control center or doctor or going for treatment.

STORAGE & DISPOSAL

STORAGE: Keep from freezing. Store in original container in a locked storage area inaccessible to children or pets. Do not store near food or feedstuffs. To prevent cross-contamination, do not store near fertilizers, insecticides, fungicides, or near seeds.

CONTAINER DISPOSAL: If empty: Do not reuse this container. Place in trash or offer for recycling if available. **If partially filled:** Call your local solid waste agency for disposal instructions. Never place unused product down any indoor or outdoor drain.

A highly refined miscible oil for winter control of certain insects. Apply in dormant period before buds open — late winter or early spring. Do not apply when spray will freeze to limbs as injury may result from the excess deposit. Remove all loose bark prior to spraying. Scales may be protected by these “shingles”. Spray to wet all twigs, limbs, and the trunk. Measure dosage to be used carefully. Add to water and mix thoroughly. Do not use mixture after standing without stirring.

HOSE END SPRAYERS

Measure the required amount of oil into the jar according to the number of gallons of spray to be used. Fill jar to proper mark with water. Stir until white cream emulsion forms. Attach to sprayer head and apply. Do not use after standing over a few minutes without re-mixing.
