PRECAUTIONARY STATEMENTS

WHAT IT IS & HOW TO USE IT:

Gordon's® Weed-No-More® Spot Weeder Ready-To-Use contains Trimec® turf herbicide, a combination of three proven weed killers 2,4-D, mecoprop-p and dicamba. Together they control a wide range of broadleaf lawn weeds; some of which are listed on this label.

Use to "spot-treat" weeds in the lawn. For best results, apply when weeds are actively growing. Do not water within 24 hours after spraying. Use as is. Do not mix. Do not dilute. Aim at weed and spray. Only a short burst is needed. Overspraying only wastes the product and may cause damage to grasses such as centipedegrass, St. Augustinegrass, and 'Floratam'. Effects begin to show after a few days and weeds gradually die. Up to 4 weeks may be required for complete kill. Be patient, Gordon's® Weed-No-More® Spot Weeder Ready-To-Use works slowly. Repeat in 3 to 4 weeks if necessary.

For lawns with many weeds, requiring an overall treatment, spray with Gordon's® Trimec® Lawn Weed Killer, a concentrate you'll have to mix with water in your hose end or hand-operated sprayer.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE OF TRIGGER SPRAYER

1. Remove sprayer from bag.
2. Unscrew cap from bottle and remove the foil seal.
3. Making sure that tube is properly inserted through hole in cap, insert tube into bottle and screw on cap.
4. Open spray nozzle approximately one full turn.
5. TO PRIME – With sprayer directed at the target area, operate trigger until spray begins (approximately 10 to 15 times).
6. Adjust the sprayer nozzle for desired spray pattern.

STORAGE OF TRIGGER SPRAYER

1. Close spray nozzle.
2. Hook the trigger on or under the bottle handle so that trigger is above the level of contents.
3. To prevent clogging of trigger, remove sprayer from bottle and pump clean water through the hose and trigger.

SPRAYER INSTRUCTIONS

How to prime and care for your sprayer

1. After shaking product well, remove cap from container and replace with sprayer hose and cap assembly. Tighten securely.
2. Turn sprayer nozzle one half turn counter-clockwise. Hold sprayer below the level of container and prime by pumping trigger 10-15 times until product is dispensed. Adjust nozzle to coarse stream.
3. To store, turn nozzle to "OFF" position and store with sprayer above level of liquid in container to prevent leakage.
